WHAT DO WE DO WITH YOUR DATA?

When you purchase something from our store, part of the buying and selling process is collecting the personal information you share with us, such as your name, address and email address. When you browse our website, we automatically receive your IP address, which provides us with information about your browser and your operating system. Internet Marketing (if applicable): With your consent, we may send you emails with information about our store, new products and other news.

PERMISSION TO USE PERSONAL DATA?

How do you get permission to use my data?

When you provide us with personal data to conclude a transaction, your credit card is verified, you place an order, specify the place of delivery or return the goods, we assume that you consent to us collecting and using it only for this specific purpose. If we want to obtain your personal data for other purposes, such as for marketing purposes, we will either ask for your consent directly or give you the opportunity to decline.

How can I withdraw my permit?

If you change your mind and do not want to receive the newsletter, you can withdraw your consent to receive messages from us, collect, use and disclose your data at any time by writing to us at the email address: info@shop.lazarski.pl

DISCLOSURE TO USE PERSONAL DATA

We may disclose your data if we are legally obliged to do so, or if you violate our regulations.

THIRD PARTY SERVICES

In general, the third party service providers we use will collect, use and disclose your information only for the purposes necessary to provide the services they provide to us.

However, some third-party service providers, such as payment gateways or other electronic payment transaction processors, have their own privacy policy regarding the information that we are required to share with them for the purpose of carrying out purchase-related transactions. Regarding these providers, we recommend that you read their privacy policies to understand how they will handle your personal data. In particular, please be aware that some suppliers may be located or based in an area that has jurisdiction other than ours or yours.

Therefore, if you decide to make a transaction that involves the services of external providers, then your data may be subject to the laws of the jurisdiction of the place where the provider or its registered office is located.

For example, if you live in Canada and your transaction is made through a US-based payment gateway, then your personal information used to conclude that transaction may be disclosed under US law, including the Patriot Act. As soon as you leave our store's website and you are redirected to a third party website or application, you are not bound by this privacy policy or our website regulations.

When you open links on our store's website, they may direct you away from our website. We are not responsible for the application of the privacy policy of external websites and we recommend that you read their privacy statements.

Google analytics: our store uses the Google Analytics website, which helps us to obtain information about who visits our pages and which pages are visited.

To protect your personal data, we take reasonable precautions and use industry best practices to ensure that data is not lost, misused, shared, disclosed, changed or destroyed.

CHANGES IN PRIVACY POLICY

We reserve the right to change the privacy policy at any time, so please re-read it frequently. Changes and clarifications will be effective immediately upon their posting on the website. If we make material changes to this privacy policy, we will notify you here that it has been updated so that you are aware of what data we collect, how we use it and under what circumstances, if any, we use and / or disclose it.

If our store is acquired or merged with another company, your data may be transferred to new owners so that we can continue to sell our products to you.
